

GOODBYE JULIA

In Sudanese filmmaker Mohamed Kordofani's impressive drama, a woman seeks redemption following an incident that threatens to destroy all she holds dear.

After a tragic accident, wealthy Muslim Mona seeks to employ poor Christian street seller Julia, even housing the young woman and her child. As their friendship develops, forcing Mona to overcome her prejudices, she struggles to hide the terrible secret that has brought them together. But escalating tensions in the household – reflecting a national mood – add to the weight of Mona's guilt. Kordofani grapples with wider societal issues through the microcosm of this riveting, intimate drama. ND
